




Introduction

"All About You"

is a Save The Children project working in partnership with the West Midlands
Consortium Education Service for Travelling Children. It is funded by the Birmingham
Children's Fund.

The "All About You" project asked Traveller children in Birmingham for their views on what they would like and what they think would make life better for them in the City of Birmingham in 2003. The work took place in schools and homes across the city. The children are from diverse Traveller communities such as Irish Travellers; Fairground Travelling Showpeople; Polish Gypsy and Czech Roma. The clear message that the children are giving is that they want and enjoy creative activities, a space to talk about their lives and to meet with other Traveller children. They want to go to school and use leisure facilities without being 'picked on' and without the fear of being called names or harassed for being who they are.

The children expressed their views through painting, talking, poetry, clay modelling work and photographs - which are presented in this booklet.

They have also made a short "All About You" video where children speak for themselves and present their views and artwork.



"My name is Daria Szukala. My date of birth is 1990-10-25. I would like to stay in Birmingham...and go to school here and meet lots of children..... and learn English......"


"I like the mix of cultures. I like the Mosques, the Pakistani people and the way the Asian women dress. I have bought the same dress since I have been here in Birmingham."







"Life would be better for Traveller children in Birmingham when people stop blazing us."





"To become a nurse/doctor. To have child support and good education. Make school be less hours please" Fiona




