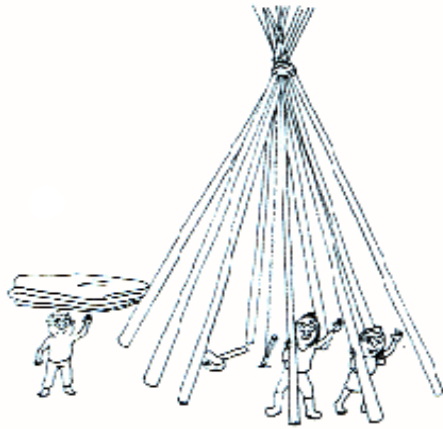


MY HOME

I live in a tipi.

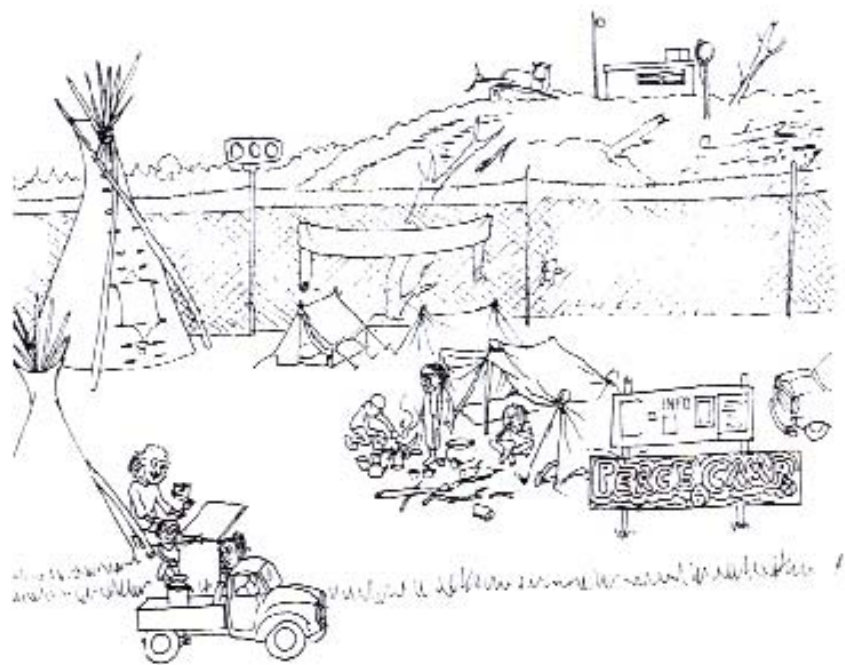

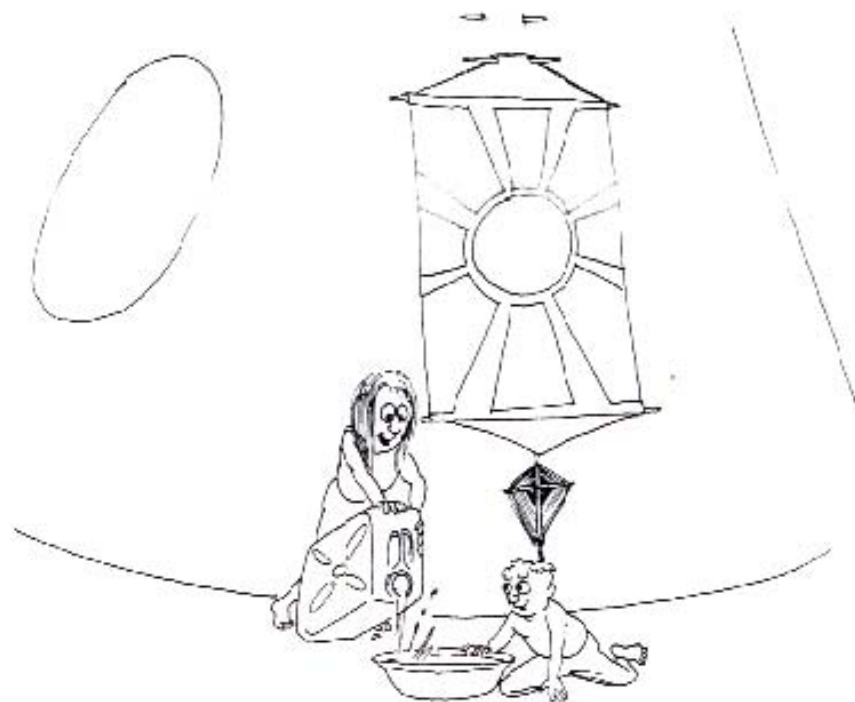

We keep warm around a fire in a small pit. It burns wood.



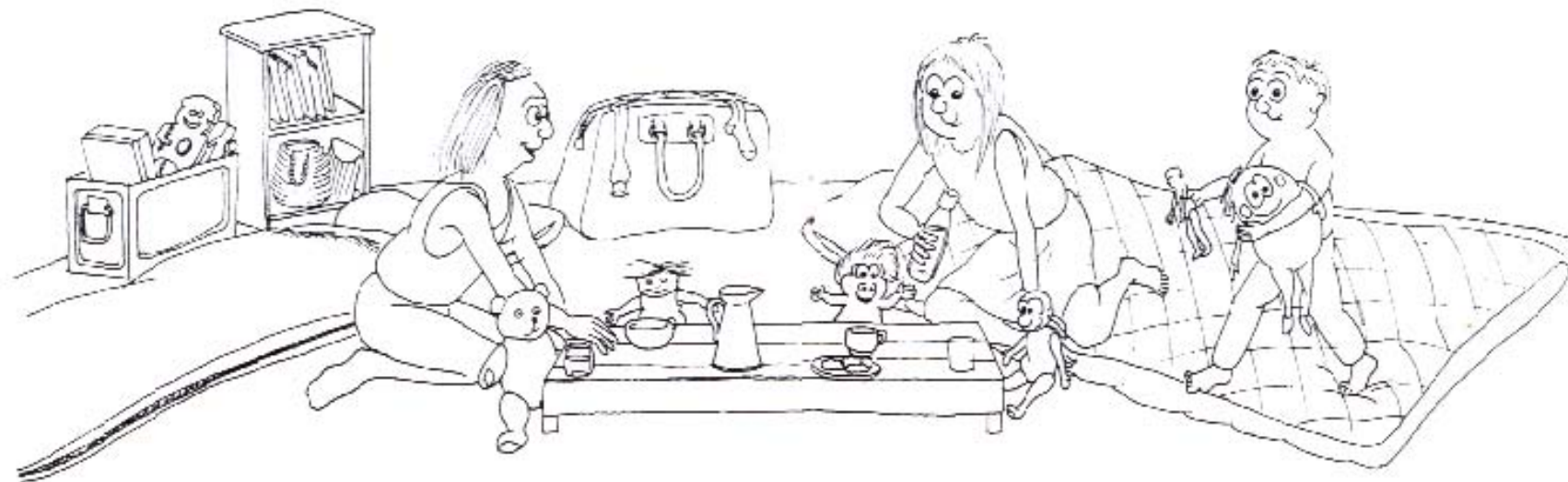
We cook over a log fire, either outside or in the centre of the tipi.



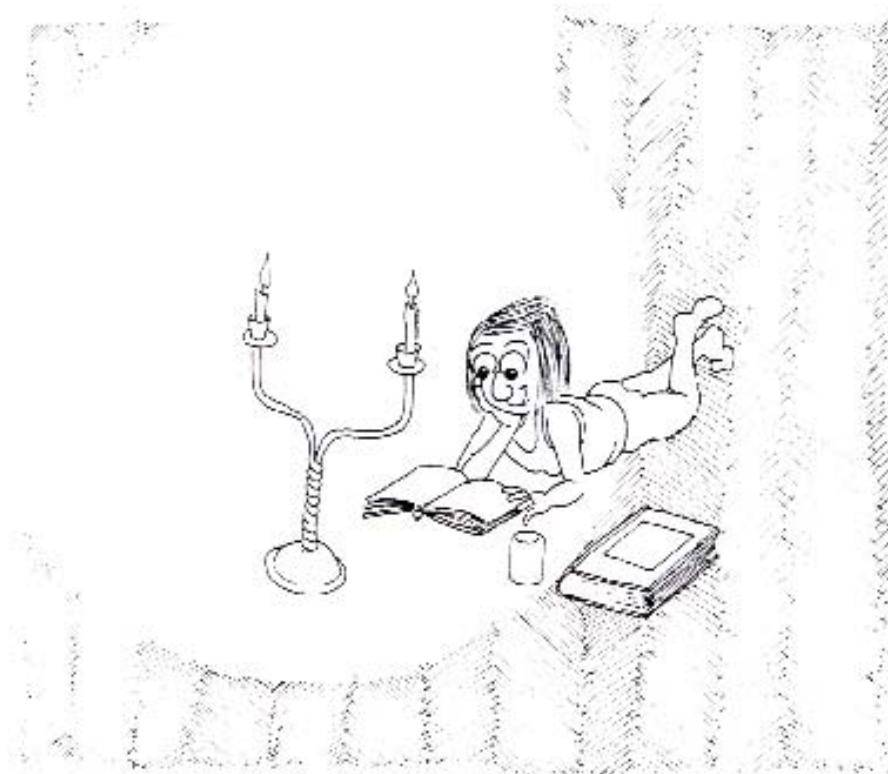
We heat water in a kettle,

tub. We hang it up to dry.



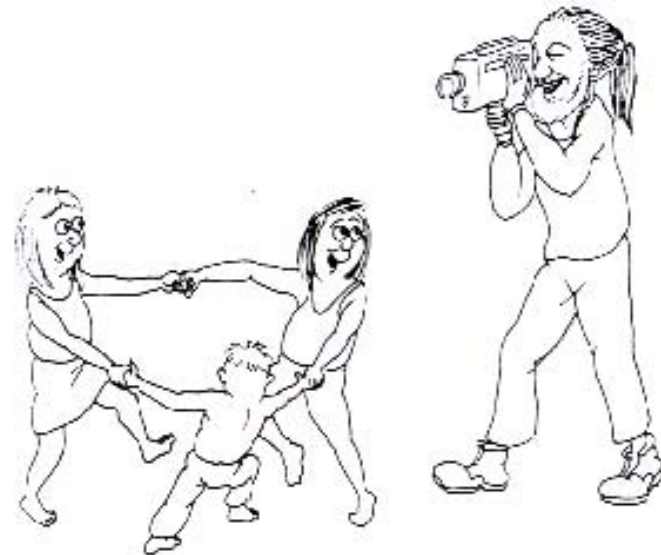
We wash in a tub outside,

our stuff in boxes and bags.



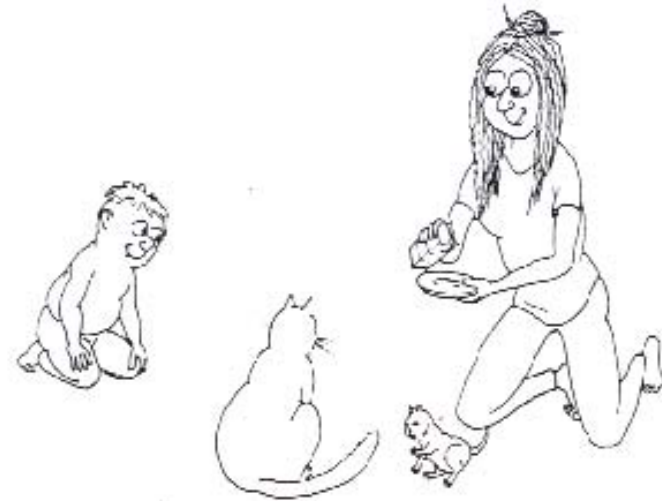
I have two candles for light. I have to be careful near them.



We have a video camera to record us playing. We have a battery to power it.



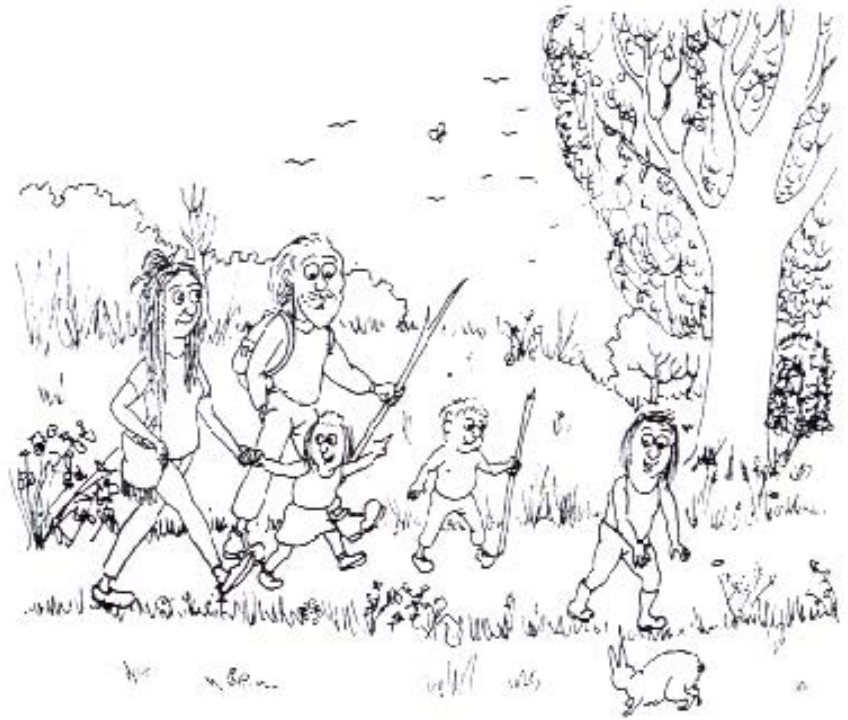
I like to paint with
my watercolours.



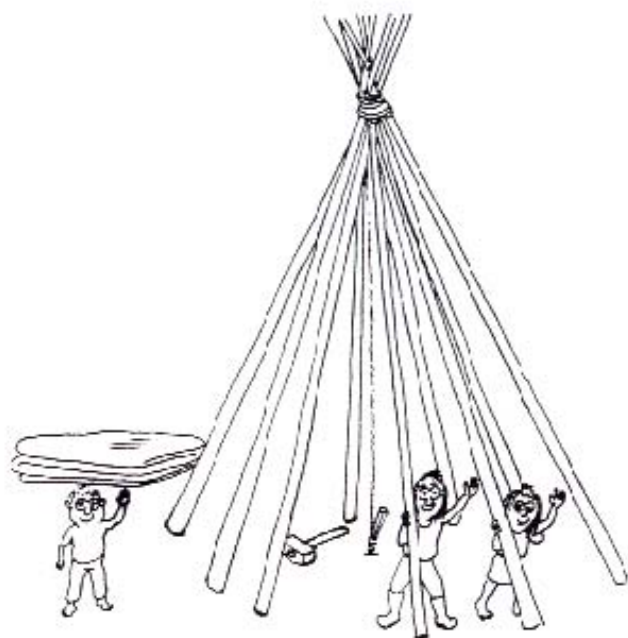
We have a pet cat and her
