Areas with large numbers of trees can often be much cooler.

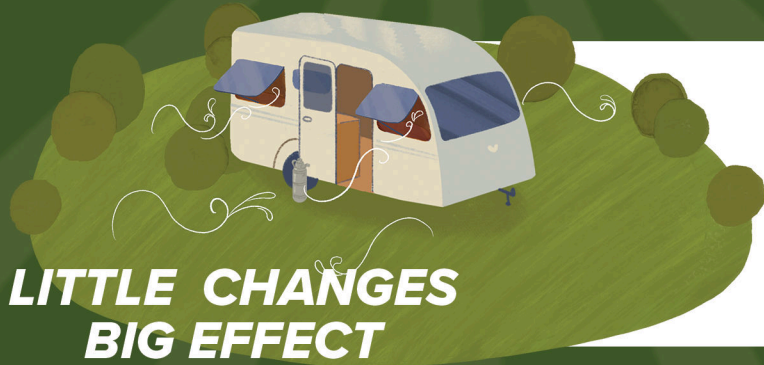
PARK IN SHADE

It's all about making sure you're not keeping heat in the trailer.

Make sure this is permitted where you are.



COOK OUTSIDE WHEN YOU CAN



Using blinds or reflective sheets can keep a van from overheating.

Opened windows can help keep temperatures down.

LITTLE CHANGES BIG EFFECT

Unused electrical appliances and generators will add to the warmth. If no one's watching that telly, switch it off.



SWITCH IT OFF



TRY TO CAMP NEAR WATER

Land near lakes, rivers and canals can be much cooler when temperatures get too hot.

Take care when near water.

Aluminium churns, stored in shade, will help keep your water cold. Try a local church if you need water.



KEEP WATER COOL



BRING YOUR OWN SHADE
