


# MY HOME

I live in a tipi.






We heat water in a kettle,




We wash in a tub outside,

the camp for our toilet.



our stuff in boxes and bags.




I have two candles for light. I have to be careful near them.

my watercolours.




We have a pet cat and her

the countryside.




Goodbye!
