I live in a showman's wagon.






Hello, I live in a showman's wagon with my mum and dad and big sister.

three steps and a canopy.




We have a heater which uses gas from a special cylinder.




We have a gas cooker in the kitchen area. It uses another cylinder.

in another bowl.




There is a shower and

We keep our toys in a cupboard.




We have an electric bulb

with our camera.




I like to make models
with my sister.




We have a pet rabbit each.
