A SIMPLE GUIDE TO REGISTERING TO VOTE IN ENGLAND

THIS LEAFLET TELLS YOU WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE.

DEADLINE TO REGISTER:

The deadline to register to vote in a particular election is 12 working days before the date of that election.

WHO TO REGISTER:

- Anyone aged 16+ (but must be 18 or older to vote)
- A UK, Irish, or Common wealth citizen
- A resident of England

UK citizens living overseas, and some EU citizens, can also register in England, but can only vote in certain elections.







HOW TO REGISTER:








INFORMATION NEEDED:

By proxy


